Management Discussion of the Performance of the CWB Onyx Diversified Income Fund

Results of Operations

In the first six months of 2023 (the “period”), the CWB Onyx Diversified Income Fund’s (the “Fund”) net assets decreased by \$1,794,793 to \$178,988,175. This reflects an increase of \$4,670,475 from investment performance, net withdrawals of \$2,871,225, and distributions to unitholders of \$3,594,043.

Series A of the Fund returned 1.96% over the period versus the Fund’s internal benchmark (the “Fund Benchmark”), which returned 2.51%. The Fund benchmark is the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index (the “Broad-Based Benchmark”). Unlike the Fund, the Fund’s return is calculated after the deduction of fees and expenses. Returns for Series O of the Fund may vary, largely due to differences in fees and expenses.

Abnormally high inflation led the Bank of Canada (BoC) to increase interest rates seven times in 2022, moving the BoC’s benchmark rate from 0.25% to 4.25%. As we entered 2023, the tone from the BoC changed suggesting that we were closer to the end of rate hikes. After a 0.25% increase in the benchmark rate in January, the BoC conditionally paused further increases and signalled that they may be done raising rates all together. Although inflation did moderate, it remained well above the BoC target of 2%, while the economy remained resilient, and unemployment remained low. This prompted the BoC to come off pause and raise rates again in June by 0.25% and once more after the period ended in July (another 0.25% increase).

Despite the increase in rates, Canadian bonds posted positive returns during the period. Long-dated bond yields have settled into a tight trading range reflecting the belief that inflation will return to 2%. Short-dated bond yields remain high (well above long-dated yields) and volatile reflecting uncertainty of the speed with which we will return to 2%. The yield curve continues to be inverted (bonds with long maturities yield less than bonds with short maturities) which is often a signal that a recession is on the horizon.

During the first half of 2023, the Fund raised its duration (interest-rate sensitivity) to a level close to the benchmark due to the view that rate increases were mostly finished. This was accomplished by holding longer dated corporate bonds to capture high coupon income and shorter dated government bonds to capture high shorter-term yields. The Fund remains overweight corporate bonds relative to the benchmark which contributed positively to the Fund’s performance.

Recent Developments

Future BoC rate decisions will be data-driven with progress on inflation moving towards the Bank’s 2% target as the main data point. We continue to believe rates will remain higher for longer, likely well into 2024 to ensure inflation moderates towards the target. We anticipate that the Canadian yield curve will be largely unchanged in

the long end, but that short rates may start to decline in anticipation of decreased bank rate pressure in 2024 and 2025.

We expect the speed and magnitude with which interest rates have risen over the last year and a half to significantly slow down economic growth. A mild recession later in 2023 or early 2024 is likely, but not certain. In such an environment we anticipate continuing to hold an overweight position in high quality investment grade corporate bonds and we expect to maintain overall portfolio duration close to the benchmark. We expect bond returns to perform more in line with historical averages going forward.

Related Party Transactions

CWB Wealth Management Ltd. (“CWB WM” or “we”) serves as trustee, manager, portfolio advisor, and principal distributor of the Fund. The Fund pays CWB WM a management fee as compensation for its services. Refer to the section titled ‘Management Fees’ for a summary of fees paid to CWB WM.

The CWB Onyx Managed Solution Funds, comprised of the CWB Onyx Conservative Solution, the CWB Onyx Balanced Solution and the CWB Onyx Growth Solution, invests in series O units of the Fund. As at June 30, 2023, 2.80% of the Series O units of the Fund are held by the CWB Onyx Conservative Solution, 6.20% of the Series O units of the Fund are held by the CWB Onyx Balanced Solution and 2.53% of the Series O units of the Fund are held by the CWB Onyx Growth Solution.

CWB WM is party to a participating dealer agreement (the “Dealer Agreement”) with Canadian Western Financial Ltd. (“CWF”), a subsidiary of CWB WM. Pursuant to the Dealer Agreement, CWB WM pays CWF a monthly trailing commission equal to $1/12^{\text{th}}$ of 0.50% of the net asset value attributable to units of the Fund held by CWF clients. This trailing commission is paid directly by CWB WM and does not increase the management fee paid to CWB WM by the Fund.

² Management expense ratio ("MER") is based on total expenses, net of waivers and refunds (excluding commissions and other portfolio transaction costs) for the stated period and is expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net asset value during the period.

³ The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net asset value during the period.

⁴ The Fund's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the Fund's portfolio adviser manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the year. The higher a fund's portfolio turnover rate in a year, the greater the trading costs payable by the fund in the year, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the year. There is not necessarily a relationship between a high turnover rate and the performance of a fund.

Management Fees

The Fund pays CWB WM an annual management fee of 1.00% of the net asset value of Series A units of the Fund. The management fee for each applicable series is calculated and accrued daily as a percentage of its NAV. The Fund's management fees were used by CWB WM to pay for the cost of managing the investment portfolio, providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions, making brokerage arrangements for the purchases and sales of the investment portfolio, providing other services, and compensating CWB WM for acting as the trustee of the Fund. CWB WM also used the management fee to fund trailing commissions and any other compensation to CWF whose clients invest in the Fund. A further breakdown of the management fee is not available for the interim period.

Series O management fee is negotiated and paid directly by each investor. Series O management fee is not to exceed the Series A management and advisory fee of the Fund.

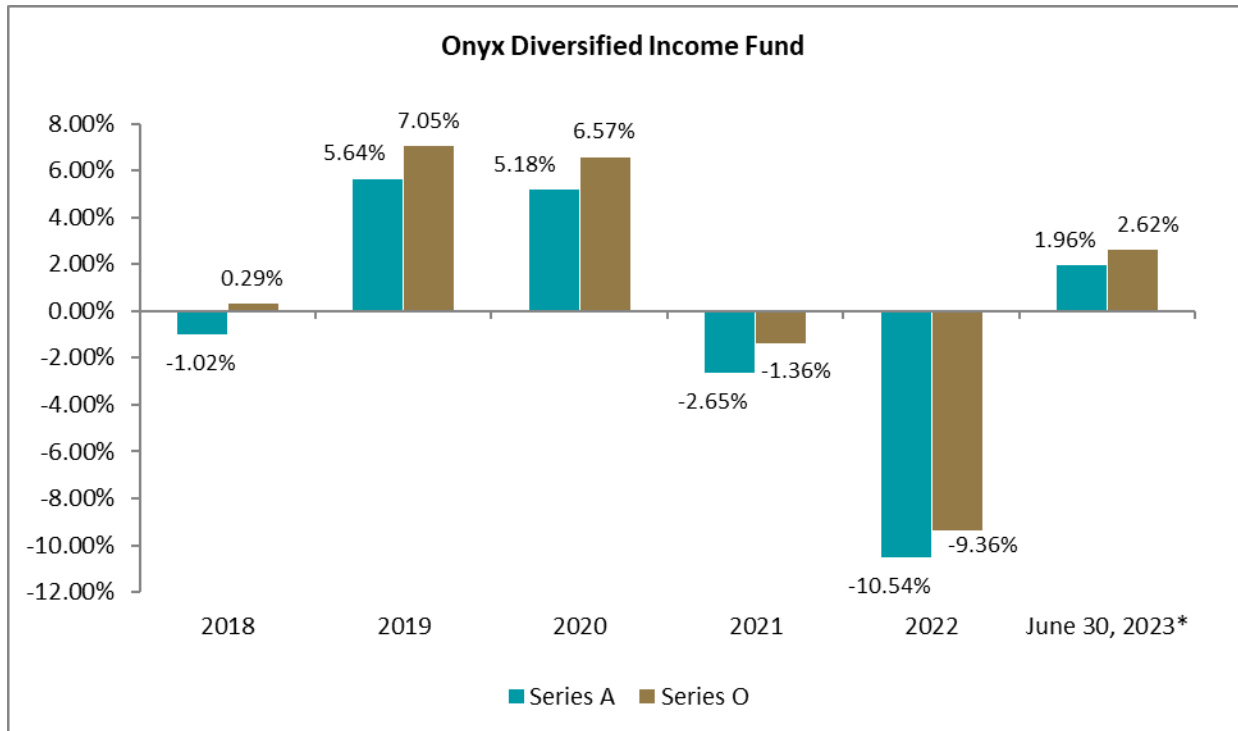
Past Performance
